

Tissue engineering is developed, which allows doctors to repair or replace damaged muscle.

Italian scientist and artist Leonardo da Vinci produces detailed and accurate drawings of the anatomy of the human body and the movements of muscles.

In Scotland, William Balfour writes the first full description of fibromyalgia.

The Greek physician Hippocrates, who is known as the "father of medicine," spends much of his life studying the human body.
