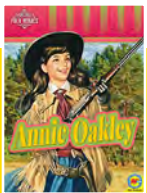

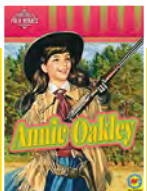

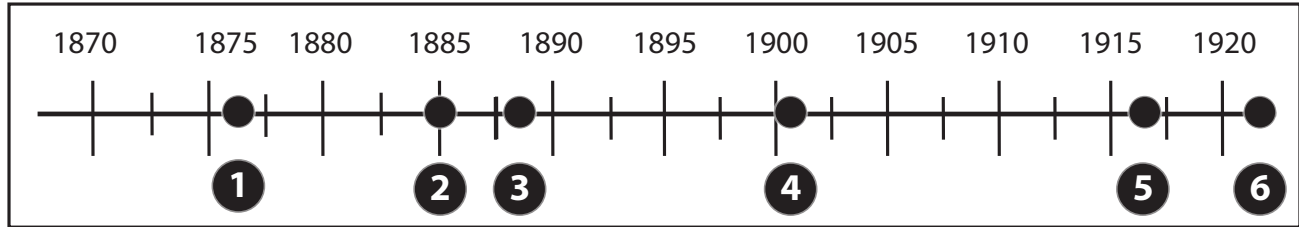

Annie hurts her back in a train accident. She must have five operations.

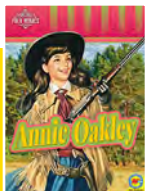
The United States enters World War I. Annie writes to the government offering to train the female soldiers. The government never replies to her letter.

Annie marries Frank Butler.

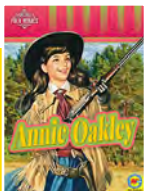
Annie joins Buffalo Bill's Wild West show.

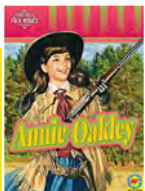

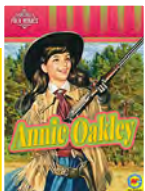

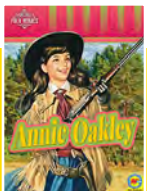
