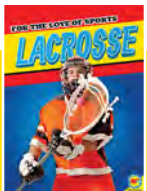

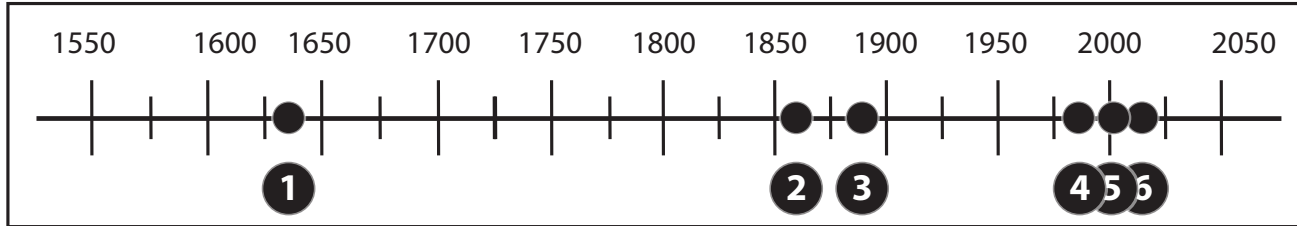

There are 11 Major League Lacrosse (MLL) teams in the U.S. National Lacrosse League (NLL).

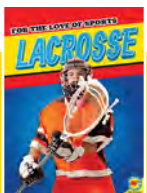
Missionary Jean de Brebeuf sees native communities playing lacrosse.

The first NCAA Women's Championship was won by the University of Massachusetts.

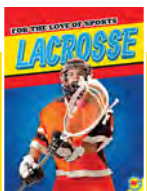
The first women's lacrosse game is played at St. Leonard's School in Scotland.

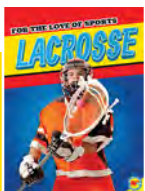

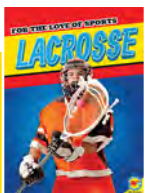
