The ninth Rugby World Cup is held in Japan. This marks the first time the event has ever been held in Asia.

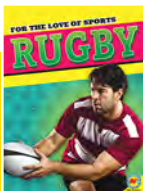
The United States wins its first gold medal in Olympic rugby.

The ball became egg-shaped.

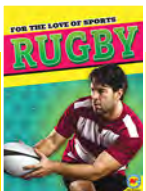
The first recorded rugby match in the United States is played.

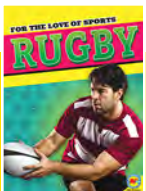
