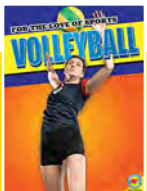

The United States Volleyball Association, which later became USA Volleyball, is formed. This organization regulates volleyball rules and plans official tournaments.

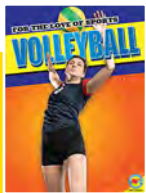
During the Tokyo Olympics, men's and women's teams can medal in volleyball for the first time.

Kerri Walsh Jennings becomes the first U.S. player to compete in four Olympic beach volleyball tournaments. She wins a bronze medal along with her teammate, April Ross.

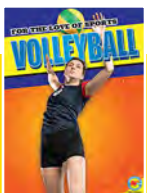

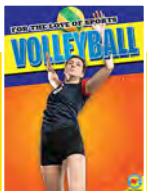

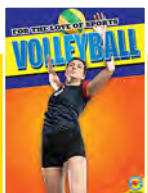

- when players jump up at the net to stop a hard spike from the other team
- fine rope linked together forming a loose kind of screen
- the line that divides the front and back zones
- holds the ball instead of letting it bounce quickly off the fingertips
- flexible rods on the net that help show when the ball goes out of bounds
- a pass where the ball contacts the forearms; arms are straight and hands are joined
- clockwise movement teams make before serving the ball; occurs after a side out is called
- the area outside the end lines and sidelines
- a soft hit with the fingertips that sends the ball high into the air so another player can spike it

- an illegal move or play called by an official
- series of three or five games
- the area between the attack and end line
- a hard, downward hit made above the net, aimed at the opponent's side of the court
- a series of hits over the net between teams
- hitting the ball overhand or underhand over the net from behind the end line
- the court area between the attack line and center line
- strong hits that result in points; usually done by spiking the ball
- gentle exercise to get the body ready for stretching and game play
- the call made when the serving team commits a fault, causing it to lose the right to serve
