5. At least this many species of redwoods have been found as fossils in Europe, Asia, and North America. Scientists believe redwoods were common in these area until about 20 million years ago.

6. Today, only 85,000 acres (34,400 ha) of old-growth redwood forests remain. Of that area, this percentage is outside Redwood National Park.
