

Hip-hop begins to appear in films, such as *Wild Style* and *Flashdance*, once more showing how widespread hip-hop has become.

Hip-hop is still extremely popular. Hamilton, the Broadway musical, won multiple Tony Awards for the use of hip-hop in song and dance.

The Rock Steady Crew dances for Queen Elizabeth II, introducing hip-hop to European audiences.

DJ Kool Herc throws the first hip-hop party.

Hip-hop group The Lockers appear on *The Tonight Show, Soul Train, Saturday Night Live*, and *The Dick Van Dyke Show*. Their appearances spread dance moves such as breaking, popping, and locking across the United States.

The Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts hosts a break dancing battle between two hip-hop groups, the Dynamic Rockers and the Rock Steady Crew. Articles in *The Daily News* and *National Geographic* appeared after this event, giving hip-hop more visibility.


