Sand dunes are hills or ridges created by sand deposits. A sand dune can be less than 3 feet (1 m) high, or taller than 500 feet (152 m).



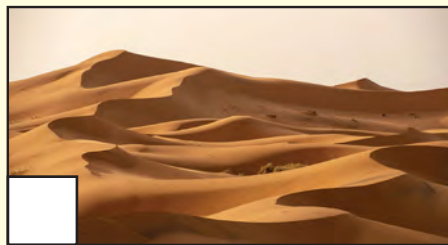
B

Wadis are dry riverbeds that come to life when it rains. Most of the Sahara's trees and bushes are found in these areas.



C

Hamadas are stone plateaus that can rise to more than 11,000 feet (3,350 m). The Atlas Mountains are examples of hamadas.

Regs make up 70 percent of the Sahara's total area. They are made up of sand mixed with red, white, and black gravel.
