

Defensive tackle Derrick Nnadi pays the adoption fees for every dog at a Missouri shelter when the Chiefs win the Super Bowl. He helps 109 dogs find homes.

In the AFL's inaugural season, Lamar Hunt's Dallas Texans play home games in the Cotton Bowl Stadium in Dallas, Texas.

The Chiefs reach Super Bowl LIV. They go on to beat the San Francisco 49ers 31–20. Coach Hank Stram and the Chiefs stun the favored Minnesota Vikings in the Super Bowl with a 24–7 victory.

Lamar Hunt decides to move the Texans to Kansas City. The Texans rename themselves the "Chiefs."

The Chiefs go 10–6 and make the playoffs for the first time since moving into Arrowhead Stadium.
