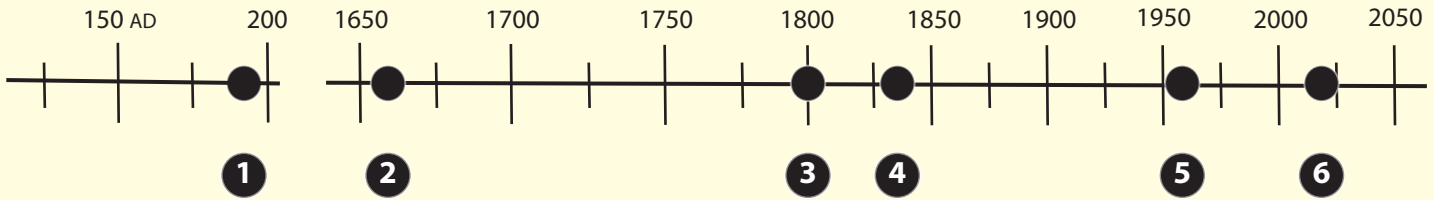


Number the events below in the order they should appear on the timeline. Write the number in the box beside each event. Check your answers on pages 16 and 17 of the book.

Dutch scientist Christiaan Huygens discovers that Saturn is a ringed planet after viewing its rings through a telescope he developed.

Athlete Roger Bannister becomes the first person to run 1 mile (1.6 km) in under four minutes.

*Once Upon a Time in Hollywood*, directed by Quentin Tarantino, wins the Golden Globe Award for Best Motion Picture, Musical or Comedy.

Septimius Severus is proclaimed emperor of the Roman Empire. During his reign, the empire expands to cover more than 2 million square miles (5.2 million square kilometers).
