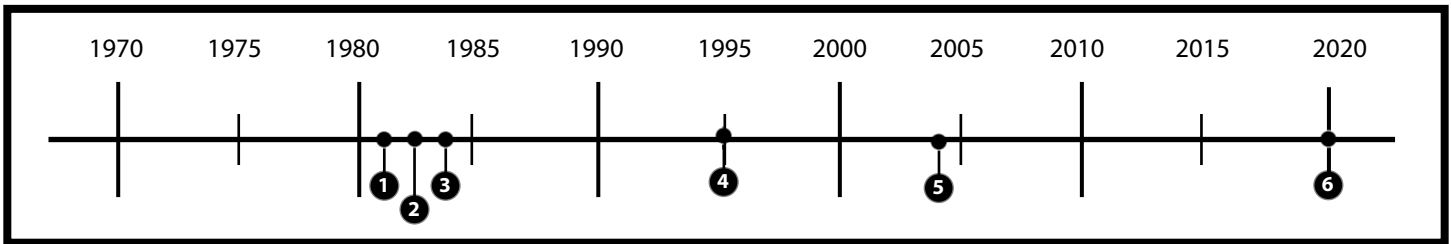

A paintball game is played in New Hampshire. The winner is a forester named Ritchie White. He captures all of his flags without firing a single shot.

The Entertainment and Sports Programming Network (ESPN) broadcasts the Paintball World Cup. It is the first paintball tournament ever shown on a major TV network.

The National X-Ball League World Cup is held in Kissimmee, Florida. San Diego's Team Dynasty team wins the championship.

Wayne Dollack holds the first scenario paintball game. This leads to large-scale events such as Living Legends and Invasion of Normandy, which can have in excess of 4,000 players.

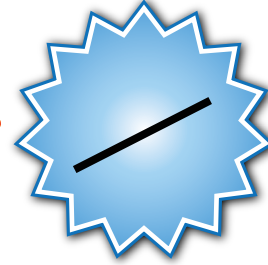
