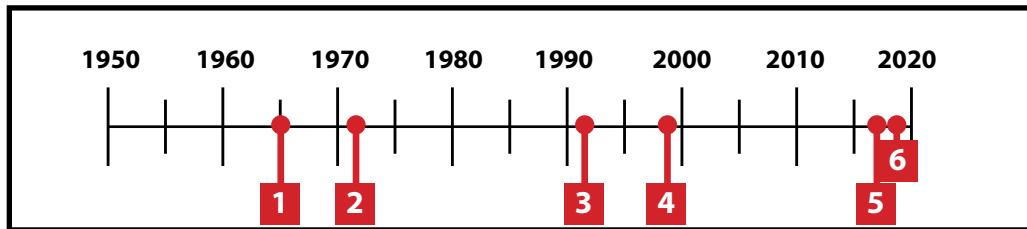

Norm Van Brocklin coaches the Falcons to a 7–6–1 win-loss-tie record. It is the first winning record in the team's history.

The Falcons reach the Super Bowl. However, they lose to the New England Patriots.

The Falcons play in their first Super Bowl. Chris Chandler passes for 219 yards and Jamal Anderson rushes for 96 yards.

The team drafts guard Chris Lindstrom 14th overall to shore up their offensive line.
