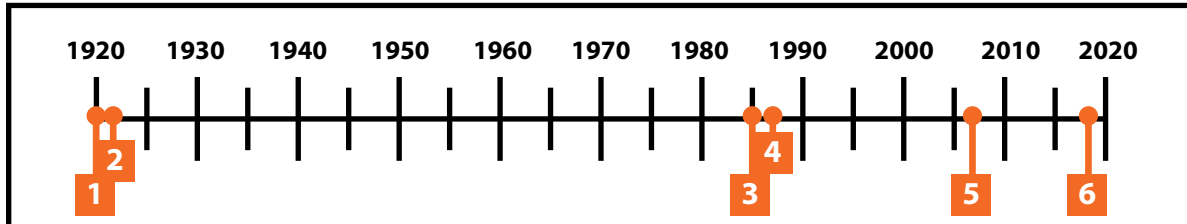


Number the events below in the order they should appear on the timeline.

On January 16, 1986, the Bears crush the New England Patriots 46–10 to win their first Super Bowl.

In February 2007, the Bears make their second Super Bowl appearance, but the Indianapolis Colts come out on top, 29–17.

The Bears celebrate their 100th season.

The Bears have one of the best seasons in NFL history. They finish the season 15–1.

The A.E. Staley Company in Decatur, Illinois, hires George Halas and Edward “Dutch” Sternaman to run their company football team, the Decatur Staleys.

The Staleys move from Decatur to Wrigley Field in Chicago and win their first league championship.
