- When did the event take place? This should include the complete date and, if possible, the time.
- Why is the event important? Explain why this was a key event for the team or player. How did the event impact the team, the players, or the fans?



The Bengals play in their first Super Bowl. They lose a tightly contested game to the San Francisco 49ers, 26–21.

The Bengals hire Zac Taylor as their new head coach.

A. J. Green and Jermaine Gresham combine for more than 2,000 receiving yards, and the Bengals win 10 games.

In their first home game of the season, the Bengals defeat the Denver Broncos. The game is played at Nippert Stadium.

One season after winning only four games, the Bengals sweep the Browns, Ravens, and Steelers to go 10–6 and win the AFC North. Chad Johnson makes his sixth Pro Bowl in seven years.

After winning another AFC Central division title, the Bengals beat the Houston Oilers 41–14 in a playoff game at Riverfront Stadium.








