

Coach of the Year Marty Schottenheimer and hometown hero Bernie Kosar lead the Browns to their first playoff win since 1969.

Arthur "Mickey" McBride names Paul Brown part owner and head coach. Following a citywide naming contest, the team is named the "Browns" in honor of their coach.












