
Write a News Story Follow the instructions to complete the activity.

- Who is the story about? This may be a person, team, organization, or company.
- What is the event? It may be a regular or post-season game, or even a practice.
- Where did the event take place? This should include the city and stadium.
- When did the event take place? This should include the complete date and, if possible, the time.
- Why is the event important? Explain why this was a key event for the team or player. How did the event impact the team, the players, or the fans?



The Colts go 11–5, making the playoffs for the second time under coach Frank Reich.

Peyton Manning leads the Colts to a 13–3 record and an AFC East division title.

Owner Carroll Rosenbloom purchases the remains of the Dallas Texans franchise and founds a new team in Baltimore, Maryland.

In a battle against the Chicago Bears, Coach Tony Dungy and quarterback Peyton Manning bring Indianapolis its second Super Bowl title. The Baltimore Colts move to Indianapolis, and in two weeks the team receives 143,000 requests for season tickets.







Write a Biography




