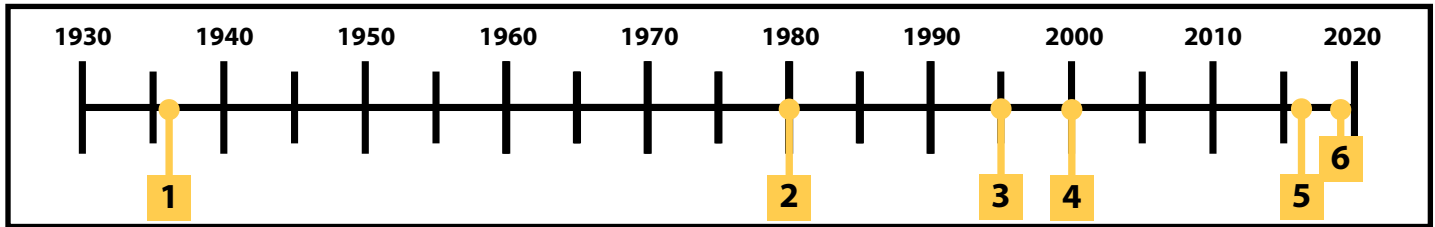

The AAFL is founded and the Cleveland Rams are charter members. The Rams join the NFL the following year.

Following their best season since 2001, the Rams reach the Super Bowl, but are defeated by the New England Patriots.

The Rams move back to Los Angeles.

In the Rams' first Super Bowl, two Steelers touchdowns end the Rams' extraordinary run. Shortly after, the Rams move to Anaheim, California.

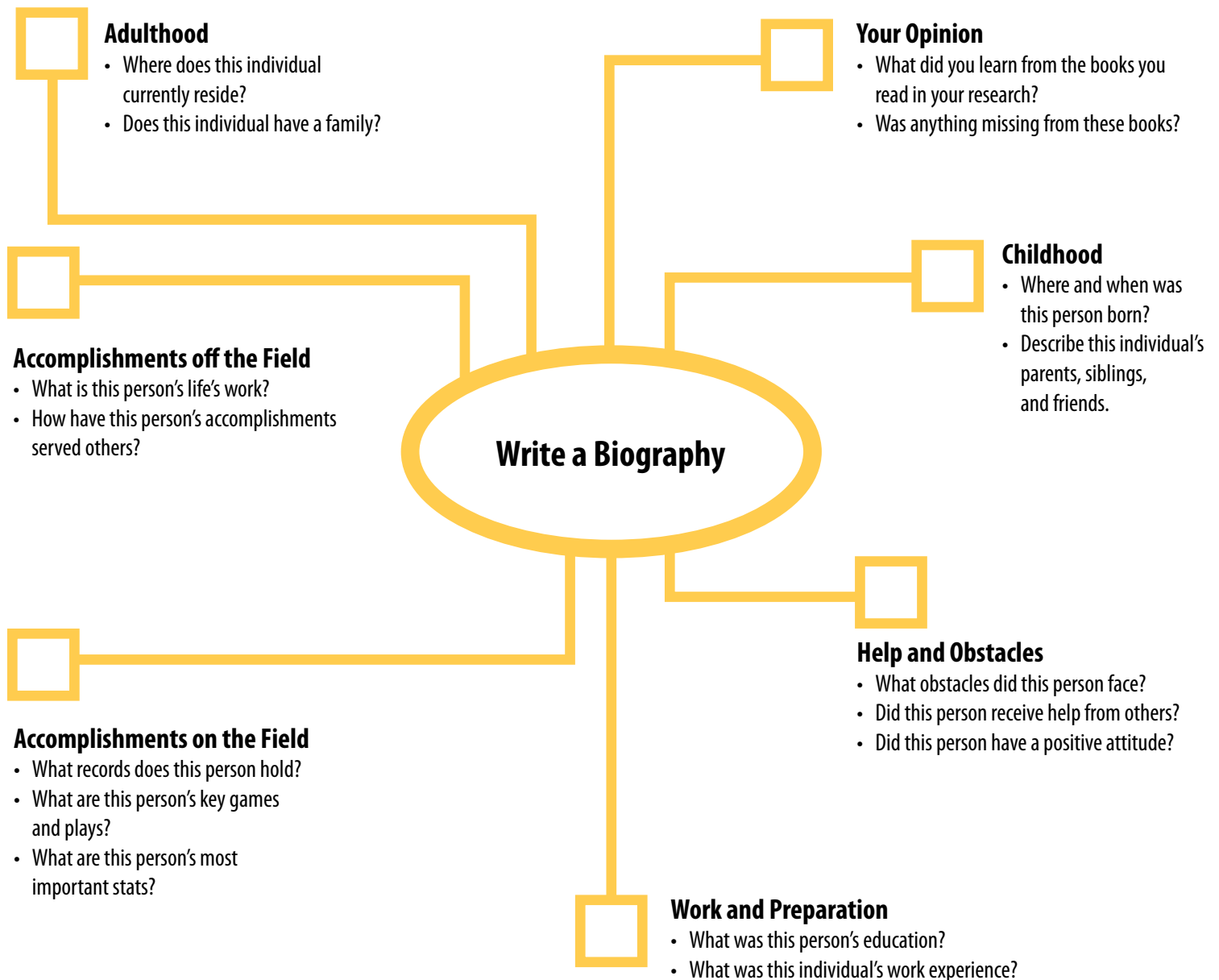

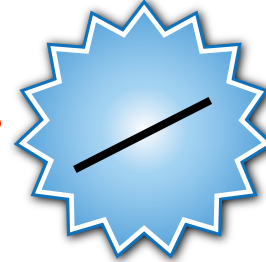

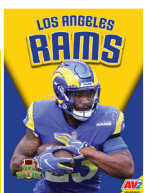
