When finished, try to find the stadiums of some of the 49ers' rivals. Write the number for each of these stadiums in the list below the map. Check your answers in the book.

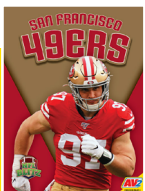

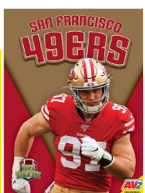

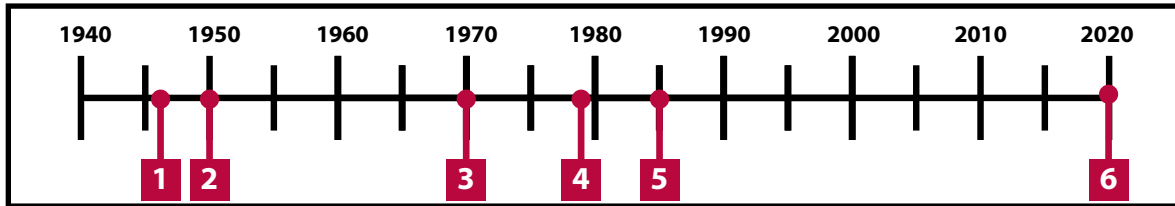

The 49ers are founded as a charter member of the AAFC.

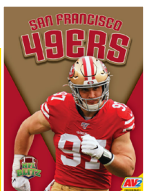
The 49ers finish the 1984 regular season with 15 wins and 1 loss. They beat the Miami Dolphins 38–16 to win Super Bowl XIX.

The 49ers play their first season in the NFL. They finish the season with three wins and nine losses.

The 49ers win their first division title under head coach Dick Nolan and quarterback John Brodie.

The 49ers win the NFC Championship, but lose to the Kansas City Chiefs in the Super Bowl.

- the player judged to be most valuable to his team's success

- short, horizontal passing routes used to "stretch out" defenses, opening up chances for long runs or long passes

- the NFL's annual championship game between the winning team from the NFC and the winning team from the American Football Conference (AFC)
- a rating given to quarterbacks that tries to measure how well they perform on the field
- a uniform that sports teams may wear in games instead of their home or away uniforms
