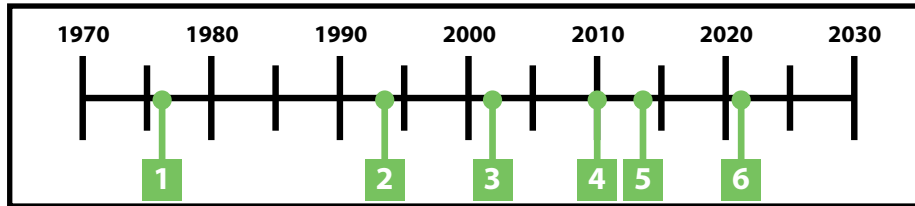

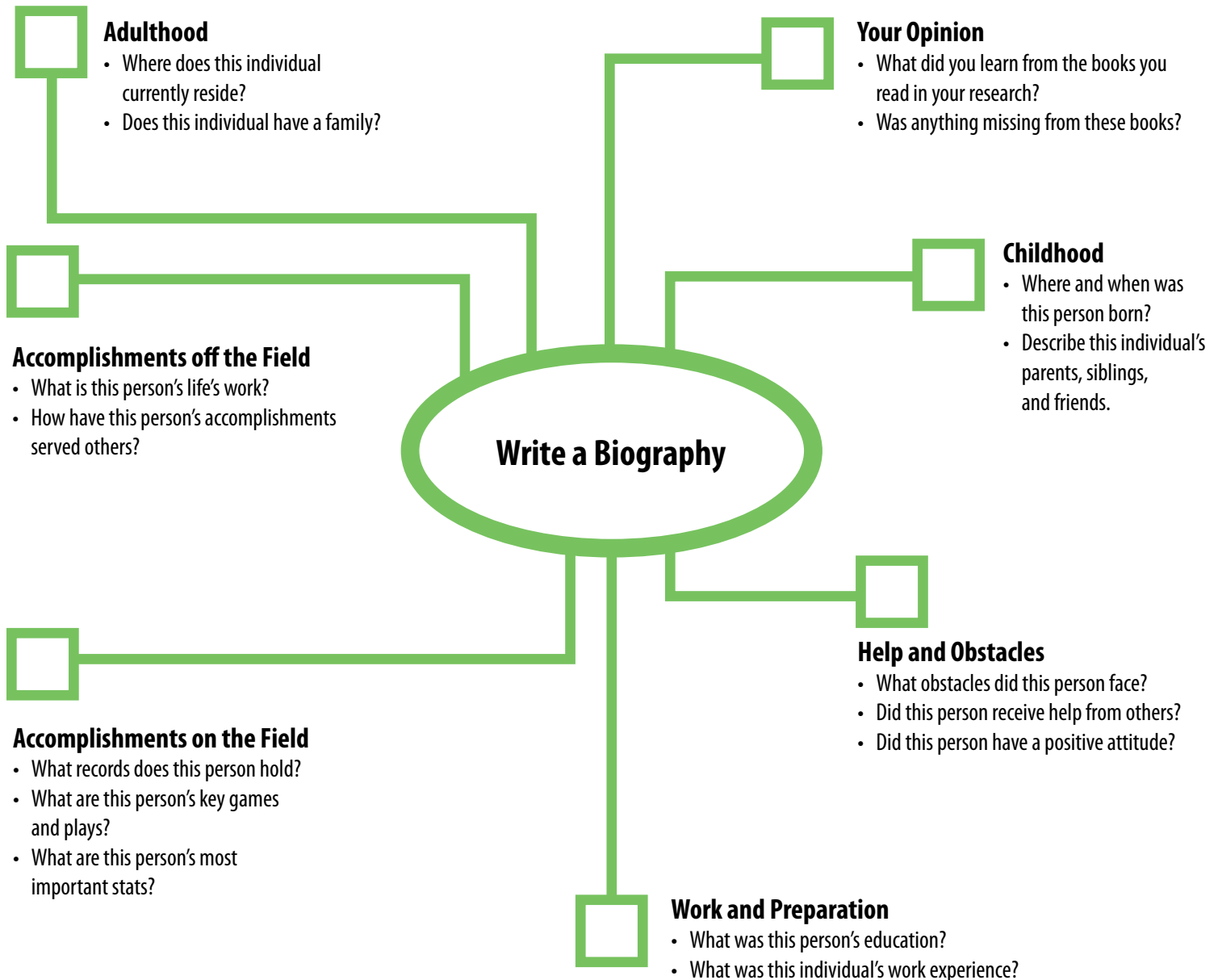

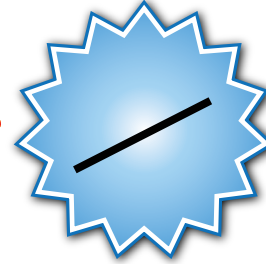

- award given to the winner of the Super Bowl each year, named for NFL coach Vince Lombardi, whose Green Bay Packers won Super Bowls I and II
- a group of persons judged to be outstanding in a particular sport
- a sporting event that takes place after the end of the regular season
- uniforms that sports teams may wear instead of their home or away uniforms
- the NFL's annual championship game between the winning team from the NFC and the winning team from the AFC
