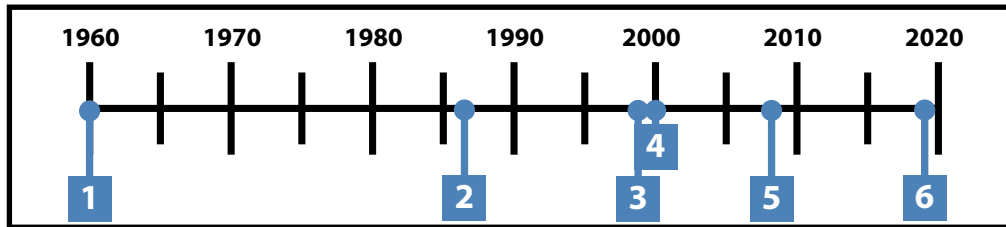

After road playoff wins in Indianapolis and Jacksonville, the Titans face the St. Louis Rams in their first Super Bowl. However, the Titans are defeated 23–16.

Rookie running back Chris Johnson gains 1,228 yards as the Titans win 13 games and an AFC South division title.

The Titans draft defensive lineman Jeffery Simmons with their first-round pick.

After two seasons in Nashville, the team re-debuts as the Tennessee Titans.

In Warren Moon's fourth year as the Oilers' starting quarterback, the team ends a streak of six-straight losing seasons.

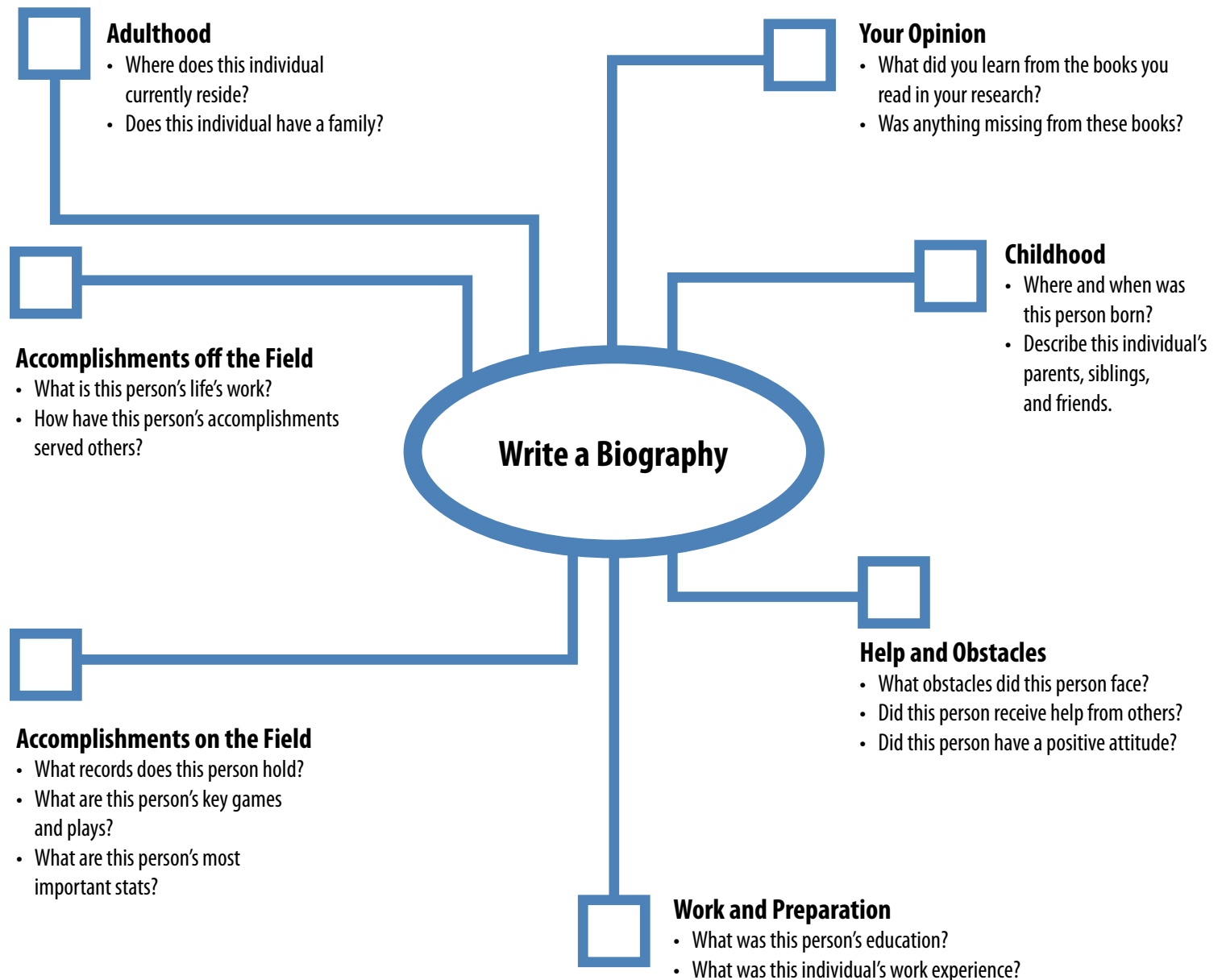

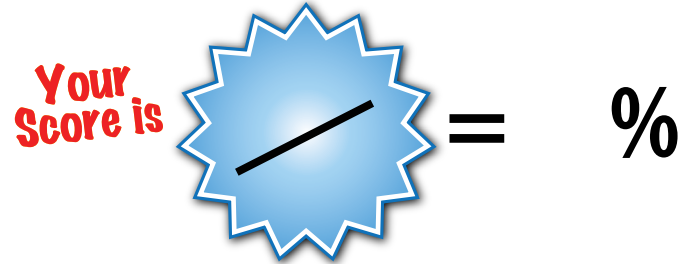
