# Create a Timeline

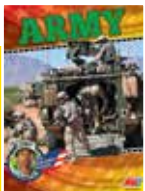

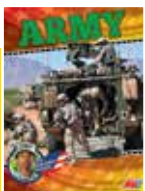

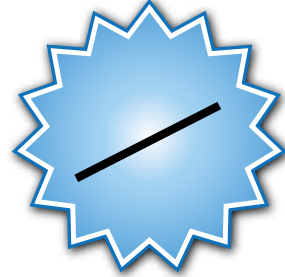
