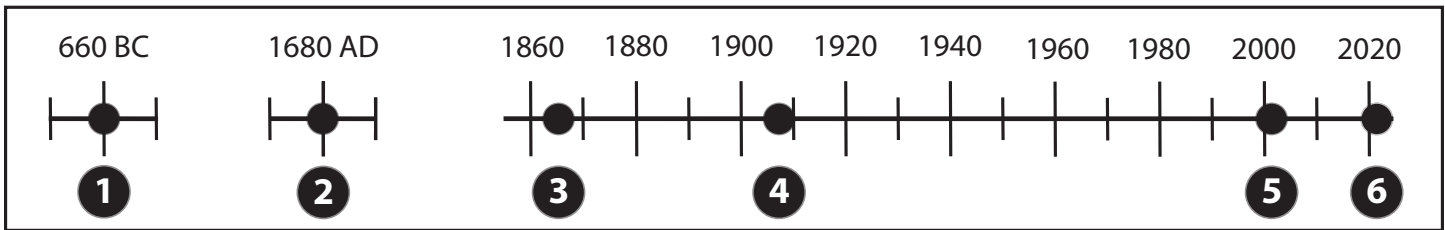


Number the events below in the order they should appear on the timeline. Write the number in the box beside each event. Check your answers with page 17 of the book.



Jack Johnson becomes the first African American world heavyweight champion.

The first known official boxing event takes place. It is held in Greece during the 23rd Olympics.

The first boxing bout held in Great Britain is recorded. By the late 18th century, the sport is introduced to the United States.

At age 14, Giselle Salandy becomes the youngest person ever to win a world boxing title.

Claressa Shields becomes the first person in the four-belt era to win undisputed championships in two different weight divisions.

The Marquess of Queensberry rules are first published in Great Britain. They were written by journalist and sportsman John Graham Chambers. These rules are still observed today.
