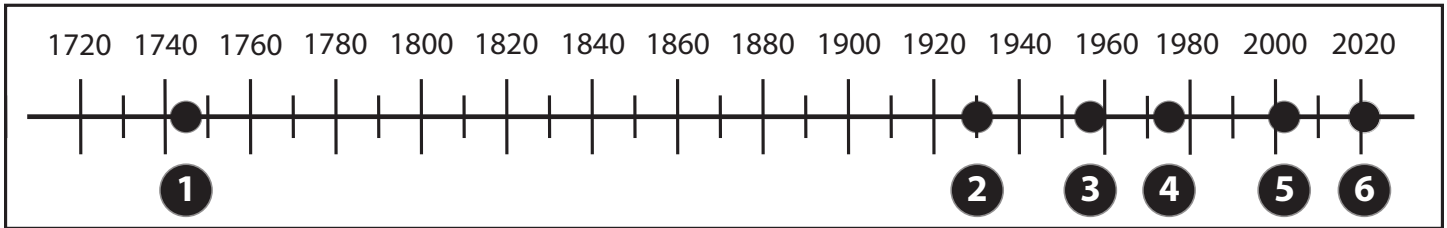


Number the events below in the order they should appear on the timeline. Write the number in the box beside each event. Check your answers with page 17 of the book.



Don Bradman scores an incredible 974 runs at the Ashes. This record for most individual runs in a Test series has never been beaten.

India's Shoaib Akhtar bowls the fastest delivery in cricket history, pitching the ball at a speed of 100.2 miles (161.3 kilometers) per hour.

The first Cricket World Cup is held in England. West Indies wins the finals, beating Australia by 17 runs.

The first set of cricket rules are written. They are printed on a silk handkerchief.

Australia defeats New Zealand at the ICC Men's T20 World Cup. This is the country's first T20 World Cup win.

The International Women's Cricket Council (IWCC) is formed. Its founding members are Australia, England, South Africa, New Zealand, and the Netherlands.
