




- e. Striking circle













The first field hockey World Cup is held in Barcelona, Spain. Pakistan takes home the gold medal.


The Hockey Association is formed in London, England. The group creates a set of rules and regulations for all field hockey teams to follow.

Field hockey players begin to wear protective equipment, such as shin and knee guards.

The first recorded use of the name "hockey" occurs when King Edward III of England bans sports for the working class.




