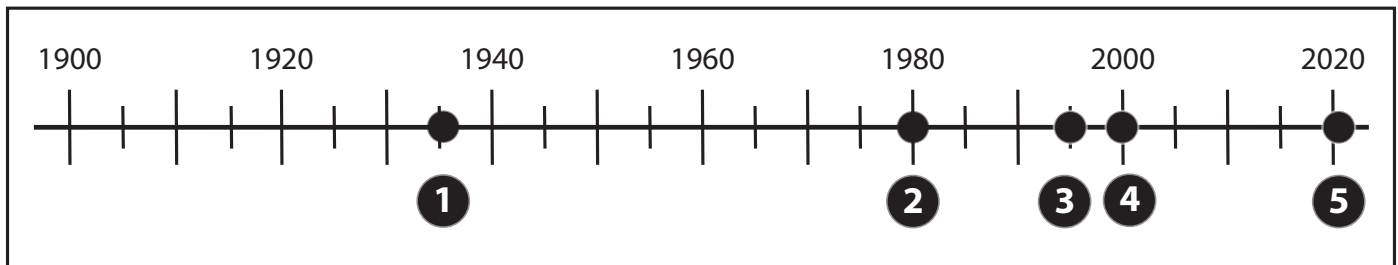


Number the events below in the order they should appear on the timeline. Write the number in the box beside each event. Check your answers using pages 26 and 27 of the book.



The Rams finish the season with a 12–5 record, finishing first in their division. Early in the following year, they defeat the Arizona Cardinals, Tampa Bay Buccaneers, and San Francisco 49ers to reach the Super Bowl.

In the Rams' first Super Bowl appearance, two Steelers touchdowns end the Rams' extraordinary run. Shortly after, the Rams move to Anaheim, California.

After 49 years in Southern California, the Rams move to St. Louis.

In Super Bowl XXXIV, MVP Kurt Warner throws for 414 yards and two touchdowns. The Rams win 23–16.

The AAFL is founded, and the Cleveland Rams are charter members. The Rams join the NFL the following year.
