6. Arena is large enough to seat about 18,000 fans for Avs games. It has been filled to capacity for nearly every game since it opened.





The Avs win in Game 7 to earn their second Stanley Cup title against the defending champions, the New Jersey Devils.


The Quebec Nordiques join the NHL when the league merges with the WHA.

The Quebec Nordiques are sold and move to Denver, Colorado. The team is renamed the Avalanche.

The Avs finish the season first in the Western Conference standings. During the playoffs, they reach the Stanley Cup finals, defeating the Tampa Bay Lightning in Game 6 to win the series 4–2.

Patrick Roy wins the Jack Adams Award for Best Head Coach.

The Avalanche wins the first Stanley Cup in franchise history in a sweep against the Florida Panthers. This is the first NHL championship for the city of Denver.




