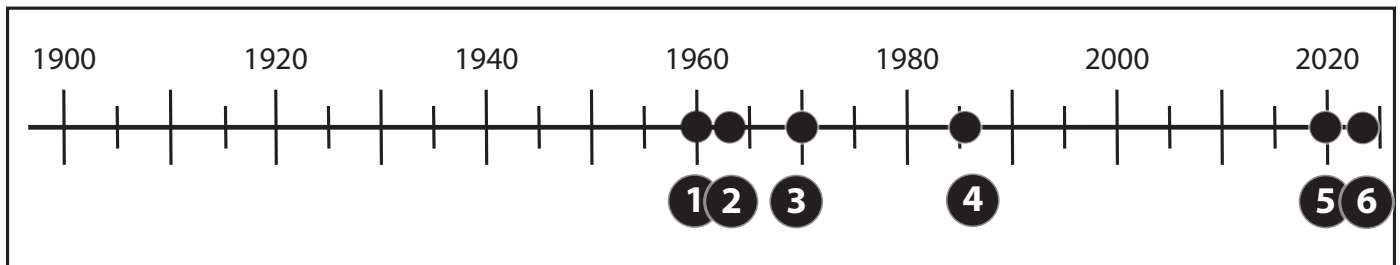


Number the events below in the order they should appear on the timeline. Write the number in the box beside each event. Check your answers using pages 26 and 27 of the book.



The Chiefs go 10–6 and make the playoffs for the first time since moving into Arrowhead Stadium in 1972.

After going 12–4 in the 2019 season, the Chiefs reach Super Bowl LIV. They go on to beat the San Francisco 49ers 31–20.

Coach Hank Stram and the Chiefs stun the favored Minnesota Vikings in the Super Bowl with a 24–7 victory.

Lamar Hunt decides to move the Texans to Kansas City. The Texans rename themselves the “Chiefs.”

In the AFL’s inaugural season, Lamar Hunt’s Dallas Texans play home games in the Cotton Bowl Stadium in Dallas, Texas.

During Super Bowl LVII, the Chiefs overcome a 10-point deficit in the first half to defeat the Eagles with a 27-yard field goal in the game’s final 8 seconds.
