- When did the event take place? This should include the complete date and, if possible, the time.
- Why is the event important? Explain why this was a key event for the team or player. How did the event impact the team, the players, or the fans?

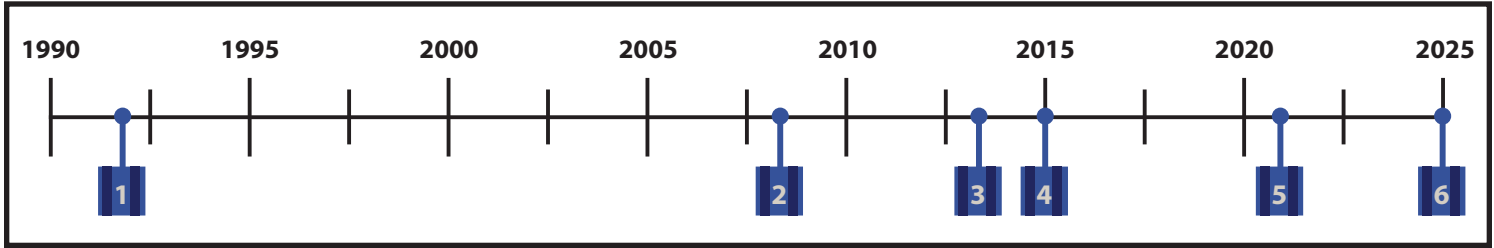

Saputo Stadium opens in May. Montréal wins their first Canadian Championship later in the year.

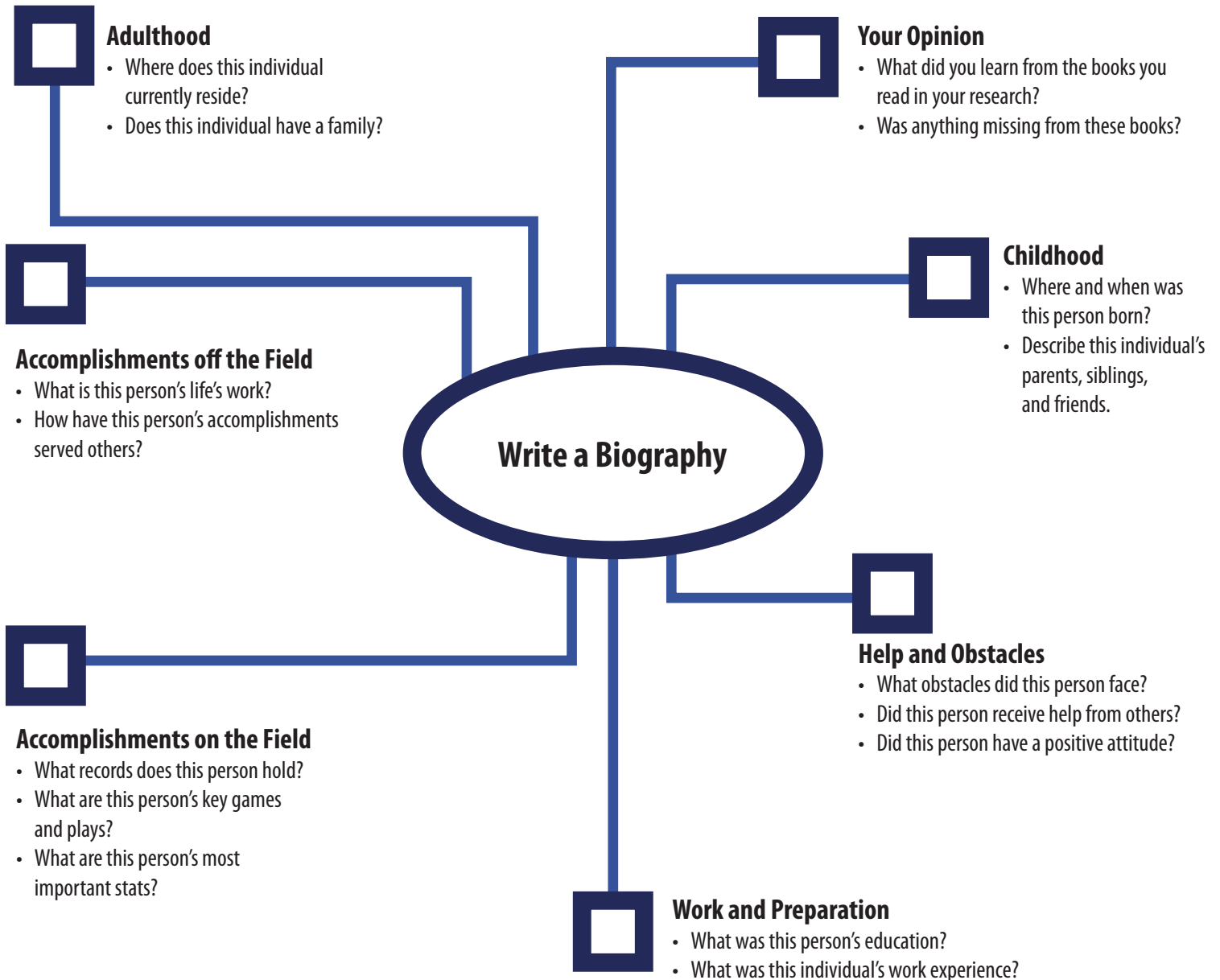
Montréal makes it to the Eastern Conference final of the MLS playoffs and advances to the CONCACAF Champions Cup final.

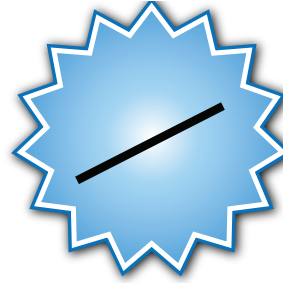
