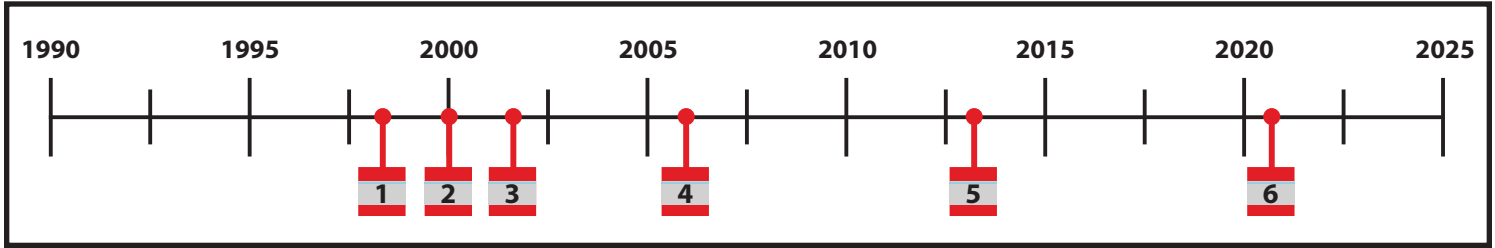

The club moves to Toyota Park in Bridgeview, Illinois, and captures its fourth Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup.

The Fire move to the newly created Central Division. They play in the MLS Cup Final against Kansas City and win their second Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup.

Chicago Fire Soccer Club plays its first MLS season and brings home "the Double." Captain Piotr Nowak is named MLS Cup MVP and Bob Bradley wins MLS Coach of the Year.

After consulting with fans, a new team logo is revealed on October 8, the 150th anniversary of the Great Chicago Fire.

Soldier Field undergoes renovations, and the Men in Red find a temporary home at Cardinal Stadium.

Mike Magee racks up a career-high 21 goals, 15 of which are scored over 22 games with the Fire. He is also named league MVP.
